



May Learning Institute Evaluation Next Steps

Thank you for attending and providing feedback on the May Learning Institute and for bearing with us as we transitioned the Learning Institute (LI) to a virtual format. MHLIC staff enjoyed hearing more about your projects and learned so much from the discussions throughout the LI. We received many meaningful responses and thoughtful suggestions in the Learning Institution Evaluation. We plan to incorporate your feedback into the September Learning Institute planning process. We received evaluations from 54 of the 86 participants for a response rate of 63%. Overall, the feedback was positive with 91% of respondents agreeing or strongly agreeing that their time was well-spent at the LI.

What participants liked	What participants would like improved
Peer learning and peer sharing	More upfront content in the breakout sessions and more consistent discussion in all breakouts
Check-ins and lunch with coaches	More time in breakouts/more time for peer discussion
Built-in breaks	Easy access to call in information and zoom links
Flexibility (i.e. to select the sessions you attended)	Consider two shorter days instead of one full day
Formatting of the LI (plenary followed by breakouts)	Shorten the introductions and opening hour
Variety in topics covered	Receive slides beforehand
